Agilent Technologies statement on Classification, Labeling and Packaging (EU Regulation 1272/2008/EC)

Agilent Technologies, as the world's premier measurement company, provides leading instrumentation and measurement solutions in the electronic and bio-analytical markets and collaborates with customers in more than 100 countries.

Agilent Technologies is aware of its obligations under in the European Union under a new regulation regarding classification, labeling and packaging of substance and mixtures, referred to as CLP 1272/2008/EC, which came into force January 20, 2009 and is directly applicable to industry.

CLP is based on the United Nations Globally Harmonised System (GHS) of classification aiming to harmonize the classification and hazard communication of chemicals (label and safety data sheet, now referred to as MSDS). It ensures a high level of protection of human health and the environment the environment and lowers barriers for global trade.

There are two key implementation timelines:

- By December 1, 2010, all substances shall be classified and labeled in accordance with GHS criteria
- By June 1, 2015, all mixtures shall be classified and labeled in accordance with GHS criteria.

Agilent will meet the implementation timelines required by CLP. This includes but is not limited to:

- Classify in accordance to new classification requirements set forth in EU Regulation 1272/2008/EC
- Update the MSDS to include updated CLP classification information
- Update product package labeling to include all new labeling requirements
- Update product packaging to ensure compliance to EU Regulation 1272/2008/EC
