

Disposal of Used ECDs

- ECD as Radioactive Waste

Environmental and Safety Regulations and Requirements for Working with ECDs

The ECD (Electron Capture Detector) is a chromatographic detector that may be used in a GC (Gas Chromatograph) instrument. ECDs from Agilent Technologies contain Ni-63 as a radioactive electrodeposited sealed source with a maximum activity of 555MBq.

Users and holders of ECDs must adhere to all applicable relevant environmental, health, safety, and nuclear regulatory requirements. The information here is for guidance only and legal responsibility remains with ECD holders and users.

This document describes how to dispose of a used ECD (an ECD as radioactive waste) when the ECD is no longer needed and/or is at the end of its operating life (EOL). Return of an unused ECD is not governed by this process.

Warning: ECDs or instruments including them must never be disposed of in WEEE or other mixed or general waste streams.

Disposal of Used ECDs

Regulatory requirements vary from country to country; some countries require the disposal of a used ECD to be done within the country and some others require the disposal to be done outside of the country. To ensure regulatory compliance and promote environment protection, Agilent strongly encourages our customers to dispose of used ECD(s) via a licensed local service provider; however, under circumstances where ECD disposal must be done by Agilent, Agilent provides two ECD disposal services - Local Disposal and Return to US Factory. Please contact the local sales representative or customer service center to obtain a quote on the relevant ECD disposal service provided by Agilent.



In countries where the removal of the ECD(s) from a GC must be done by licensed personnel, customers should have a licensed service provider remove the ECD(s) from their GC or call Agilent for ECD removal service before ECD disposal arrangement.

Agilent strives to serve our customers and comply with local regulatory requirements; as a result, country-specific service coverage is offered - please refer to the table in Appendix for the list of ECD disposal service coverage by country. The coverage is accurate as of the date of publishing and is subject to change to meet US NRC and local regulatory requirements worldwide; please always check with your Radiation Safety Officer and local Agilent customer service center to get the latest information about ECD disposal.
