Software Maintenance Agreement (SMA)

Bundled into MassHunter Explorer software is a one-year software maintenance agreement.

The software maintenance agreement does not include installation services. Installation or upgrade services must be purchased by contacting your sales representative in your region.

Requirements

Requirements

To receive a license, you must:

- Be named as the software, install, or contact person during purchase.
- Have an Agilent.com account.
- Obtain the entitlement certificate ID for this software from the License and Delivery portal.

Before you begin:

- Ports 7070 and 7071 need to be open for licensing to work. If other software
 use the same ports, it needs to be uninstalled before activation of the
 MassHunter Explorer software.
- If you **do not** have an Agilent.com account, an email invitation to set a password is sent to the individual indicated as the point of contact after purchase. The email address is no-reply@mailing.agilent.com with the title Agilent Software and Licensing Portal: Account and Password Verification.
- If you **do have** an account, an email with the Entitlement Certificate is automatically sent to the individual indicated as the point of contact. This email address is donotreply_agilent@flexnetoperations.com with the title Your Agilent Entitlement Information.

If you have not received the expected email for your product, contact your vendor or internal support.




5 The Download Packages screen loads. Click the MH Explorer 1.0 w/Introductory Data link.





These instructions should only be used by customers with standalone workstations. MassHunter Explorer cannot be installed on networked workstations.


Before installing the MassHunter Explorer software, you must uninstall any previous version. See "Returning MassHunter Explorer software licenses and uninstalling" on page 35.

1 Navigate to the directory where the MassHunter Explorer software installation file is saved. Right-click, then select **Mount**.



This action opens a virtual drive that is visible in File Explorer.

- 2 Select all the files in the mounted drive, then copy and paste them to a directory on the C:\ drive.
- **3** From the directory on the C:\ drive, double click to run the setup program, **MassHunterExplorerSetup.exe**.






Activate MassHunter Explorer Software

- 1 Double click the **MassHunter Explorer 1.0** icon to open the program.
- 2 Upon launch, the Activate MassHunter Explorer dialog box displays. Click **Activate**. The Agilent Licensing window displays in a browser window.




- **3** Verify that the type of License Activation method is **Online Activation**.
- 4 From the entitlement email, copy the Activation ID.



- **5** Paste the Activation ID into the **Activation ID** field.
- 6 Ensure that the License Activation option is selected.

A confirmation message will flash along the bottom of the screen.







4 From the entitlement email, copy the **Activation ID**.






- 6 Enter the **Number of licenses**.



- **9** Transfer the *OfflineActivationRequestXXX.bin* file generated to a PC with Internet access.
- **10** Log into the License and Delivery Portal using your Agilent.com credentials.
- 11 Select Offline Device Management.



- **12** Click **Choose File**, browse to the folder where the *OfflineActivationRequest.bin* file is located and select the file.
- 13 Click Upload. The license is generated for download.




14 Click the **here** link to download the license file, *capabilityResponse.bin*, to the default download folder.



15 Copy the capabilityResponse.bin file and move it to the Installation PC.


Returning MassHunter Explorer software licenses and uninstalling

1 Open the MassHunter Explorer software and click **Validated License** in the lower right corner of the window.



The Agilent Licensing Portal opens in a browser window.

2 Locate the license for the installation in the table, change the Total value to 0, then click **Update**.



The following message will flash on the screen.




3 Close the MassHunter Explorer software application.

4 Open the Microsoft Control Panel program.




5 Click Uninstall a program.



NOTE

The MassHunter Explorer software's dependencies (.NET Framework and the License Server) are not be uninstalled with this process. If these items also need to be uninstalled (not recommended) then they can be uninstalled through the 'Add/Remove Apps' workflow available with Windows.
