



Agilent Counterfeit Electronic Components Prevention Policy

Agilent is committed to preventing the introduction of counterfeit electronic components into our products. To achieve this we will:

1. Use electronic components that are manufactured by or for the original component manufacturers.
2. Inform our suppliers of this policy and hold suppliers accountable for compliance.
3. Maintain appropriate processes and provide ongoing training to Agilent employees and suppliers to assure electronic component authenticity.
4. Investigate all incidents of suspected counterfeit electronic components reported to Agilent's supply chain management.
5. Maintain appropriate processes to isolate quarantine and remove counterfeit electronic components from Agilent's supply chain, and make appropriate disclosures to the proper authorities.

This policy applies to the Agilent Technologies' Chemical Analysis Group, Electronic Measurements Group and Life Sciences Group.
